

LFM Church In-Person Service Procedures

- Throughout the week, there is a standardized daily sanitizing procedure in place for the whole church performed by Wee Care staff which will also be followed on Sundays.
- If you or anyone in your family have been exposed to Covid-19 or have any of the symptoms*, please choose to remain at home.
- We strongly encourage you to wear a face mask and will provide disposable ones (But please bring your cloth mask from home if possible), but it is not mandatory.
- Upon arriving, parking will be guided to ensure CDC distancing recommendations, and you will be asked the CDC symptom* questions.
- Entrance and restroom doors will be opened by a host to minimize touching.
- The main entrance (East) will have designated entry and exit doors.
- The south, covered entrance will be designated for the handicapped.
- As you enter we ask that you allow us to scan for temperature, and then you will be seated by a "host" (front to back) and dismissed at the end to help maintain the recommended 6-foot distancing. For the time being, choosing your seat is not an option.
- There will be a posted pedestrian traffic flow into, within (including restroom use) and exiting the church in order to maintain recommended social distancing.
- Restroom hosts (outside) will moderate room capacity for safety, but emergencies will be accommodated.
- Since there are no separate kid's programs at this time, children will need to remain with their parents and parents will assume responsibility for their children maintaining social distancing.

We will be continuing our full online service for those who are vulnerable or unable to physically attend.

* Fever, Cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste/smell
